Proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide proof of vaccination against bacterial meningitis. Students must submit this documentation prior to registering for classes and the vaccine must be valid on the first day of the semester. Your student may submit their vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

Register for a Parking Permit

Students may register their vehicle using the T2 Cardinal Cars app via the GoUIW portal. The information below will be needed to request a permit. Visit uiw.edu/parking for more information.

- Valid email address (your student will be required to verify their account using this email)
- Vehicle license plate number and state
- Vehicle make, model, color and style

Submit Health Insurance Waiver

All UIW students must have medical insurance. If your student is already insured on a family plan, make sure to waive coverage by the first day of the semester to avoid charges. Visit bit.ly/uiw-waivers for more information.

Register for a Payment Plan
