Both academic transcripts and board test scores are evaluated during the admissions process to determine eligibility for a merit award.

Presidential Scholarship - **\$12,000 per year**

Dean's Scholarship - **\$11,000 per year**

Distinguished Scholar Award - **\$10,000 per year**

Achievement Award - **\$8,000 per year**

Catholic High School Scholarship

\$2,000 per year - Eligibility: Any student graduating from a Catholic high school.

Direct Admit Scholarship

\$2,500 per year - Eligibility: High school graduates admitted to the Direct Admit option. Renewable for up to eight years, as long as students are meeting the program requirements. More information: www.uiw.edu/healthprofessions

McCracken Alumni Referral Scholarship (MARS)

\$1,000 - UIW Alumnus/a may nominate one student for a one-time scholarship. Eligible only for first-time, first semester students at UIW. Deadlines: Spring - **Dec. 1** / Fall - **Feb. 1**.

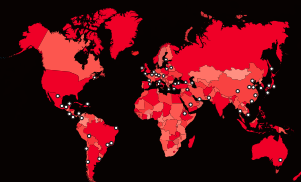
