AID OPTIONS

We recommend utilizing your full Federal Unsubsidized Direct loan (\$40,500), due to the low fixed interest rate. The remaining budget can be filled by a loan of your choice, but the total cannot exceed \$44,171, including any other aid you receive, such as scholarships.

LOAN ACCEPTANCE

Go to studentloans.gov to complete Loan Entrance Counseling, and the Loan Agreement (Master Promissory Note/MPN) for the Unsubsidized Direct Loan. COSTS AND FINANCIAL AID - PHASE 1

Phase 1 students for 2017-2018 have an annual tuition of \$52,600.00 and a student fee of \$2,000.00 for a total direct cost of \$54,600.00. The financial aid cost of attendance (or "budget") for Phase 1 students in 2017-2018 is \$84,671.00. This budget is intended to cover tuition & fees, and assist with room, board, transportation, and personal expenses. After deducting the direct costs of \$54,600.00, students can expect a living expense total of roughly \$30,071.00 for the year, minus associated loan origination or disbursement fees.

For our DO students, aid is required to be disbursed in no more than two disbursements over the course of one phase. It's important to budget living expenses accordingly, as these dates are not adjustable. The budget and disbursement dates for Phase 2 will be different than Phase 1.

If you purchase a laptop/computer or have childcare expenses, you may submit a Cost of Attendance Adjustment Form to have your budget increased (http://www.uiw.edu/finaid/documents/coal8.pdf).

Refunds are mailed from the Business Office via paper check or direct deposited to your account shortly thereafter (no later than 2 weeks after the disbursement date.)

- * Fall anticipated charges include tuition, the student fee, and health insurance. The health insurance fee of \$1245 can be waived on the Business Office website (http://www.uiw.edu/busoff/waivers.html) if you have your own insurance coverage. Estimated charges does not include a laptop.
- ** Fall refund must be budgeted to last until approximately Feb. 16, 2018, when you can expect your second living expense refund. No further refund will be received until Phase 2 begins.
