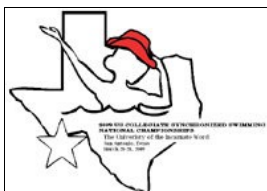

Father Tom will present information about "Mutism: the Darkside of Deafness" interspersed with information about his own struggle through seminary and ordination; and his recent legal struggles with the City of Castle Hills to be allowed to keep the nine members of the Deaf Apostolate of Saint Dominick whom he is mentoring in his house. UIW Chancellor, Sister Helena Monahan of the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word of San Antonio will begin with an opening prayer.
