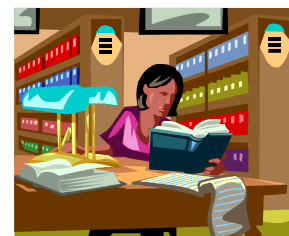


## **Chorale & Madrigal Concert: May 4**
