<p>Mentor System</p>	<p>One local student is assigned to an exchange student to help with airport pick-up, orientation and settling in.</p>
<p>Welcome event / Orientation week (dates)</p>	<p>September 14, 2016 February 26, 2017</p>
<p>Airport pickup</p>	<p>Yes, but fees caused should be paid by the exchange student. Fee for airport pick-up service is around NT\$1200 per person. (Fall Semester Only)</p>
<p>(Intensive) language courses offered during the semester (Fee-Paying Courses)</p>	<p>Yes. But the Chinese Courses in our Chinese Language Center (CLC) are fee-paying courses. Students need to pay for these language learning programs. The tuition fee depend on the learning hours per week as follows: - 10-15 hours per week, 3 months: NT\$20,000-23,500 (full learning) - 6 hours per week, 3 months: NT\$12,000 - 4 hours per week, 3 months: NT\$8,000</p>

Other useful information / Comments

<p>Visa procedures</p>	<p>Students should handle their visa application in their home countries prior to entry to Taiwan. Please apply for a visitor (1 semester study)/resident visas (1 year study) at the nearest Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) or the embassy.</p>
<p>Health Check Forms for Visas</p>	<p>1-year exchange students should complete the Health Report (FORM B) in their home country prior to apply a residence visa. 1-semester exchange students are required to complete the Health Report (FORM C), but the X-ray check is suggested to do after entry to Taiwan. **All of foreigner students are required to do a X-Ray check after they enter to Taiwan.</p>
<p>Special Academic Programs</p>	<p>The Chinese courses of Chinese Language Center have no credit (0 credit) and may cause extra fees for students. Bachelor students are not allowed to attend the higher level courses (ie. Master/PhD Programs). Master/PhD students can take a lower courses, yet is unable to get an equivalence credits for a graduated or post-graduated studies. *ISTM courses now is all fee-paying courses, reciprocal students should get permission to take the courses from the ISTM courses and probably caused extra fees in its programs.</p>
