To be eligible to apply, you must:

- have a 3.0 or higher GPA
- be a full time undergraduate student who has completed at least 12 semester hours at UIW, not exceeding 95 semester hours, and not graduating in May 2019
- have a passport that is valid for at least 6 months after your return or have applied for a passport
- be in good standing at the university
