Below are some Next Steps to help your student on their journey at the Nest

Visit the Office of Financial Assistance

Meet with our financial aid staff to discuss your Cardinal's financial award and available options. Develop a financial plan to prepare for any out-of-pocket costs.

Confirm Their Attendance

Pay their confirmation fee at uiw.edu/confirm (not required for part-time and non-degree-seeking students).

Make Sure Your Cardinal Has Access to the Cardinal Apps Portal

With their Cardinal Apps account, students can check their schedule, UIW email, account balances and more. Ensure your Cardinal has access to their UIW email, the official UIW communication portal.

Submit Proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide proof that they received a vaccination against bacterial meningitis during the five years preceding the first day of classes. Your Cardinal can submit their vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

Sign Up for On-Campus Housing (Optional)

Is your Cardinal considering living on campus? View residence halls and apply at uiw.edu/housing with a \$225 deposit.

Submit Final Documents

Students must submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions at admissiondocs@uiwtx.edu before the start of classes.

- Final official high school transcript (including final GPA and graduation date)
- Official college transcript (for students who took dual credit courses)
