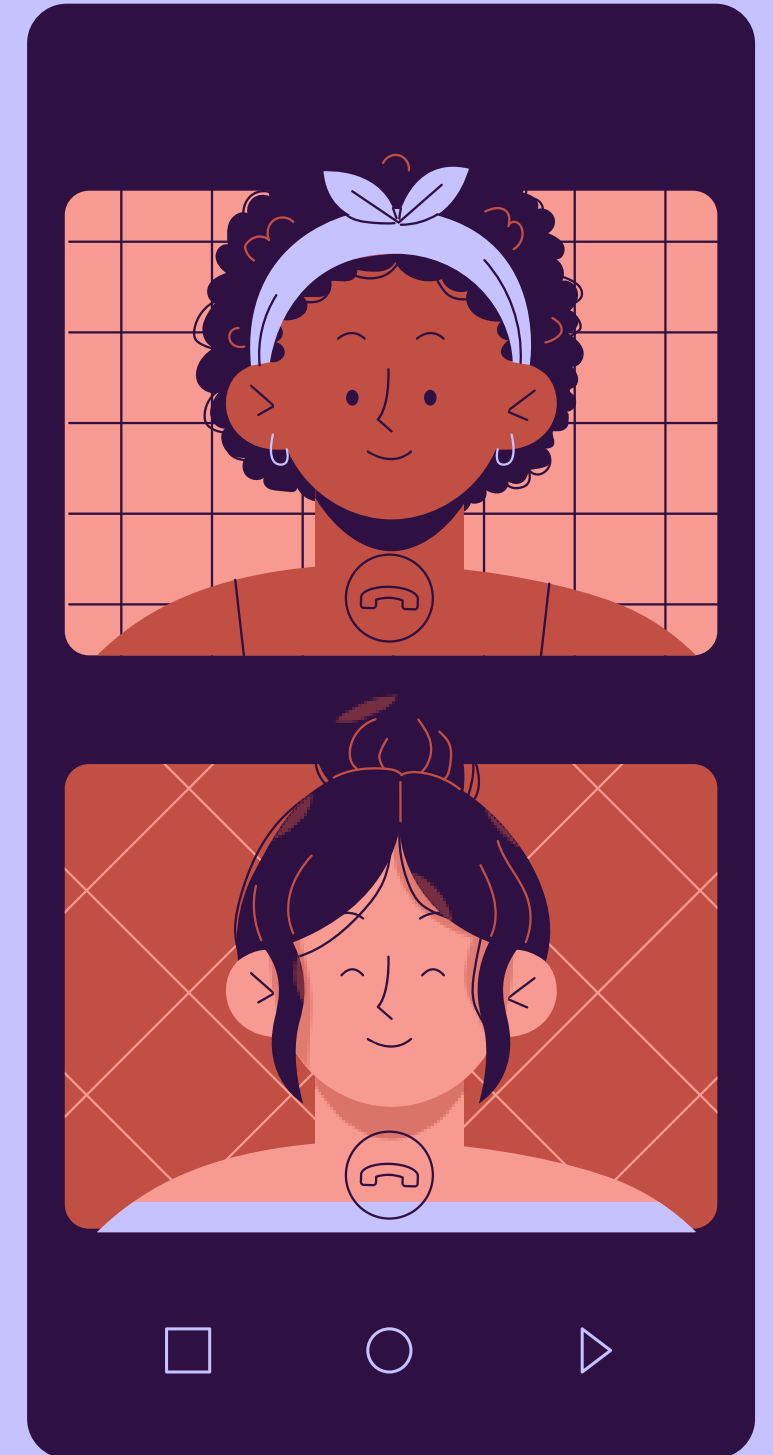
# If These Things Happen...



- Students have the right to report the incident and receive a prompt, equitable resolution.
- Students have the right to report to law enforcement, as applicable.
  - This includes going to a hospital for treatment and collecting evidence, if needed.
- Students have the right to request and receive supportive measures.

- We have 3 Confidential Reporting Locations:
  - Behavioral Health (Counseling)
  - Health Services
  - Mission & Ministry
- Mandatory Training is required of all freshman and incoming transfer students.
