JAKOB RINDERKNECHT, PhD Moody Professor 2024-2025

Jakob Rinderknecht is the 2024-2025 Moody Professor. Established in 1971 by the Moody Foundation, the Moody Professor reflects a high level of scholarship, teaching excellence and community service attained by the recipient. This is the highest faculty honor bestowed by UIW. The Fall Commencement address given by the Moody Professor is traditionally considered to be the students' "last class."

Jakob Karl Rinderknecht is the Director of the Honors Program and Associate Professor of Religious Studies at the University of the Incarnate Word. He studies how embodiment and culture shape the Catholic Church in its internal and external relationships. He is currently President of the North American Academy of Ecumenists.

Recent works include Mapping the Differentiated Consensus of the Joint Declaration, (Palgrave, 2016, winner of the Harding Meyer Prize in Ecumenism) and a critical translation of Karl Rahner's An Ecumenical Priesthood: The Spirit of God and the Structure of the Church (Fortress, 2022). His current book project argues that the field of ecumenism must attend to the wounds that Christians have inflicted on each other by participating in colonialism, enslavement, and the structures of abuse and exclusion.

UNIVERSITY OF THE INCARNATE WORD MISSION

The first Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word, three young French women motivated by the love of God and their recognition of God's presence in each person, came to San Antonio in 1869 to minister to the sick and the poor. Their spirit of Christian service is perpetuated in the University of the Incarnate Word primarily through teaching and scholarship, encompassing research and artistic expression. Inspired by Judeo-Christian values, the Catholic Intellectual Tradition, and Catholic Social Teaching, the University of the Incarnate Word aims to educate men and women who will become concerned and enlightened citizens within the global community.

The University of the Incarnate Word is committed to educational excellence in a context of faith in Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Word of God. Thus, through a liberal education the university cultivates the development of the whole person and values of life-long learning. To that end, faculty and students support each other in the search for and communication of truth, thoughtful innovation, care of the environment, community service, and social justice.

The Catholic identity of the University of the Incarnate Word is shaped at its deepest level by the meaning of the Incarnation, which is the foundation of all Christianity and is expressed through the core values of the Mission: faith, truth, education, service and innovation.

- Faith The University is committed to educational excellence in a context of faith in Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Word of God.
- **Truth** The faculty and students support one another in the search for and the communication of truth.
- **Education** The University educates men and women who will become concerned and enlightened citizens.
- Service The curriculum includes a global perspective and an emphasis on social justice and community service.
- **Innovation** The University is open to thoughtful innovation that serves the spiritual and material needs of people.



THE MOODY PROFESSOR

The Moody Professorship was established in 1971 at the University of the Incarnate Word and Our Lady of the Lake University through a grant made to the two institutions by the Moody Foundation. A faculty member is named Moody Professor from each institution annually and, in turn, delivers two public lectures. The awarding of the Moody Professorship reflects the level of scholarship, teaching excellence and community service attained by the recipient. The Moody Professor is the faculty member chosen to lead the faculty and carry the University Mace.

THE ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn by faculty and graduates during Commencement contributes to the color and excitement of the special occasion, and its origin dates back to the medieval universities of Paris and Bologna during the 12th and 13th centuries. There is still some doubt as to whether the academic regalia finds its sources in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. The long gowns may well have been necessary for warmth in the drafty medieval university, with the hoods serving to cover the tonsured head until later replaced by the skullcap. A headdress known to us today as the familiar mortarboard, too, replaced the skullcap.

Early rules for the construction of academic gowns were quite strict; at Oxford, for example, the tailor who departed so much as a "nail's breadth" in the making of any part of the academic regalia was punished by the vice-chancellor of the university. While the basic design of academic regalia remains essentially the same, with black as the predominant color, many European universities have elaborated upon the design and some American universities have dropped black in favor of the predominant university color. The faculty of the University of the Incarnate Word wear some of these designs and gowns.

The bachelor's gown displays the university steeple on red cuffs. The master's gown, designed to be worn closed, has pointed sleeves. The doctor's gown is further distinguished by velvet facing down the front plus velvet bars (Chevron) across the sleeves "of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains."

Caps and hoods complete academic regalia. The bachelor and master's mortarboard is made of a material to match the gown and the uniform black tassel is worn to the right before a degree is conferred and to the left thereafter. The doctor's cap is often made of velvet, and in a variety of shapes, and may also have its tassel of gold thread. The immediate difference between hoods is the length. The master's is three and one-half feet, and the doctor's is four feet, with the latter also having panels at the sides. Hoods are trimmed with velvet, the width increasing with each degree, and the trim color pertains to the degree received. Hoods are also lined with the official college or university colors. All University of the Incarnate Word hoods are lined with red, white and black. The degree the student is receiving is indicated by the color on the hood they are wearing.

GRADUATION HONORS

Honors announced during the Commencement ceremonies are anticipated honors based upon grades posted to the student record, excluding the current active semester. The honors posted on the transcript, as part of the student's official record, are based upon all grades earned, to include transfer work, through the final semester. The posted honors may differ from the announced honors. Undergraduate students who complete associate or baccalaureate degree requirements and have met residency requirements at the University (excluding pass/fail courses) are eligible to graduate with honors. The level of honors will be determined by the grade point average achieved in all college-level semester hours earned at the University. For the distinction Cum Laude, the student must have a 3.5 cumulative average. To graduate Magna Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude, the student must maintain averages of 3.7 and 3.9 respectively. Graduate students who complete their programs with a 4.0 average graduate With Distinction. Honors are not awarded at the doctoral level. The gold cording worn by our students signifies graduation with honors and is a gift from our bookstore, Follette Higher Education Group.

HONORS PROGRAM

The Honors Program at the University of the Incarnate Word adds a level of intellectual inquiry to stimulate curious minds. It provides a challenging curriculum, community development, and an emphasis on students pursuing their own academic interests in collaboration with faculty. It also provides ample opportunity to reflect on and work for social justice. Included are co-curricular programs in all types of artistic and academic fields and service-learning opportunities in and out of the classroom. This is an interdisciplinary Honors Program for students with excellent academic credentials, a love of learning and a desire to make a positive difference in the world.

The program brings students together with faculty from across the University in a variety of academic and co-curricular programs. By the end of the program, students will have honed their analytical skills, experienced the meaning of social responsibility and gained confidence as citizen-leaders. Graduates of the UIW Honors Program are designated at graduation by wearing the Bachelor's hood appropriate to their degree.

REPRESENTATIONAL FLAGS

The flags displayed during the Processional and Commencement represent the home countries of the students who graduate today. As an institution, UIW welcomes international students of diverse backgrounds to our community in the belief that their respectful interaction exposes all students to cultural similarities and differences thus developing an understanding of and appreciation for other diverse cultures.

Our 419 international students represent 73 countries, including Mexico, Canada, India, Honduras, Spain and Germany. UIW is the only American institution with two campuses in Mexico that offers double degrees from both Mexico and the United States at Centro Universitario Incarnate Word in Mexico City and at the UIW Campus Bajío in Irapuato.

COMMUNITY SERVICE IMPACT

At the University of the Incarnate Word, we take great pride in our students' commitment to serving their communities near and far. The graduating classes of December 2024 contributed roughly 24,281 hours of service, resulting in a remarkable economic impact of \$813,171 in volunteer hours. We aspire to see our students carry on this legacy of service and dedication as they become compassionate and engaged members of our global society.

Students who contributed toward the Senior Class Campaign may wear the UIW Senior Class Campaign lapel pin. This is the only adornment worn on the academic gown that is authorized and sanctioned by the academic leadership of the University.

UNIVERSITY MACE

The University Mace is carried at the beginning of the Academic Procession by the Faculty Marshal. This symbol of the University was hand wrought by Dr. Donald McLain, professor of Biology, in the Centennial Year 1981. The open orb of silver is in a lacy pattern incorporating 12 symbols of the University representing Christianity, Education, the University, and the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word. The Celtic cross at the top is set with sapphires.

OATH OF A PHYSICAL THERAPIST

- I will be humble.
- I will recognize my limitations and will continue to consult with my colleagues and co-workers for knowledge with which I can better treat my patients and for the inspiration to expand and augment my education.
- I will share my knowledge with my colleagues and patients freely, with compassion and patience.
- I will work toward the improvement of the quality of life for all of my patients.
- I will honor the choices that my patients make with respect to their wishes and needs.
- I will do no harm to another human.
- I will work to improve the practice of physical therapy so that all who seek it will receive treatment which is proper, ethical and just.
- I will not allow my judgment regarding the practice of my profession to be influenced by race, creed, religion, greed or unethical behavior.
- I will expect the same behavior from my colleagues and co-workers.

Thus, with this oath, I freely accept the obligations and rewards which will accompany my practice of physical therapy.
